NEW SESSIONS FOR FEBRUARY:

1. **ASSESSING FEEDING & SWALLOWING ISSUES– EDUCATION SERVICES**
This is the same session presented in early December 2011. Participants will view video clips of residents during mealtime. Discussion will follow regarding the identifying the feeding and swallowing issues presented and what the health care worker might do to promote safe feeding in this situation.

2. **ARE ALL PRESSURE ULCERS PREVENTABLE? (MB Tel) - PRESENTED BY ALEXANDRA BEEL & SARAH BROWN, WRHA PALLIATIVE CARE CNS**
This session will define and describe what a Kennedy Terminal Ulcer (KTU) is, and explore the difference between a KTU and a "Pressure Ulcer".

3. **VIOLENCE DE-ESCALATION – DSM Rounds (MB Tel)** are meant for all DSM staff. These sessions are also a requirement under the Workplace Safety and Health Act. It would be beneficial to encourage front line staff to attend these Telehealth sessions.

4. **2012 CNA CERTIFICATION EXAMS – PRESENTED BY CANADIAN NURSES ASSOCIATION (CNA)**

5. **JOB HAZARD ANALYSIS (JHA) – DSM Rounds (MB Tel)** is a requirement under the Workplace Safety and Health Act and MANQAP. In the JHA sessions, there will be discussion of how to recognize issues, determine how to classify them and what forms to fill out while determining the JHA. Safe Work Procedures (SWP) will also be discussed. We will also show staff what forms to fill out, how to fill them out, where to find them as well as what to do with them once both the JHA and the SWP are completed

The ongoing development of existing and emergent leaders is critical to quality care environments and strong nurse leaders play a significant role. These qualities are not only the expectations but the responsibilities of the charge nurse leader. This session will focus on the application of the Standards of Practice and the charge nurse role.
