Long-Term Care

Misericordia Health Centre provides long-term care with a team approach that makes its elderly residents feel valued and part of a special community.

Misericordia Place | 204-774-6581
100 residents, 99% full with 30 admissions annually

Misericordia Place is connected to Misericordia Health Centre through an enclosed walkway. The personal care home offers residents private rooms they can personalize and make feel like home. Residents can enjoy the company of others for meals and take part in recreation and social programming.

Interim Care | 204-774-6581
150 residents, 93% full with about 259 admissions annually

Interim care residents live within the health centre in a comfortable home-like environment while they wait to get into a personal care home of their choice.

Team Approach

Residents of Misericordia Place and the interim-care areas are cared for by an interprofessional team that includes physicians, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, health-care aides, dietary support, a social worker and numerous dedicated volunteers.

A recreation facilitator plans social and recreational programs that include activities such as bocce ball outdoors in warm weather, shuffleboard, cards or knitting groups.

Volunteers help residents to chapel, deliver newspapers, assist in sending and receiving emails or simply share a good book by reading to residents.

A spiritual care associate is available to provide spiritual and emotional support.

Residents also have access to specialized services such as eye care, urgent care and rehabilitation services.
